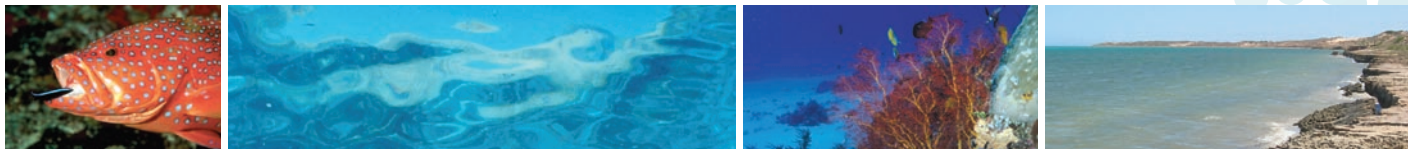


wamsi node 1 symposium
